UHS offers services that include allergy/immunotherapy injections, general medicine, laboratory and radiology services, minor procedures, nutrition and dietetics, pharmacy, physicals, sports medicine, travel medicine, women's clinic and sexual health services, and more. Health Insurance

All international students at OSU are required to have insurance throughout their program of study. The cost of medical care in the United States is very high and insurance helps limit those costs. Waivers of this requirement are only allowed for those who have insurance granted by U.S. Employer plans and Governmental sponsored programs. If you are one of these students, please contact the ISS Office at iss@okstate.edu to determine if you are eligible for a waiver of this requirement.

How Health Insurance Works

When an individual purchases medical insurance, his or her premium is combined with the premiums of others to form a pool of money. That pool is then used to pay the medical bills for those participants who need medical care. For most U.S. nationals and international students alike, insurance is the only protection against expensive medical costs and unexpected emergencies.

Once you purchase a medical insurance policy, you will receive an insurance identification card from the company. This card is valid only as long as you continue to pay your insurance premium. It will show the name of the insurance company and the policy number and often will indicate a telephone number to call in case of emergency or for answers to questions. If you become sick or injured and seek medical treatment, you need to notify your insurance company as soon as possible. They must receive a written request for payment (called a claim), that they will review before they can make a payment. Always provide the company with complete and accurate information on the claim form; otherwise, they will be unable to evaluate the claim and make payment. Sometimes the insurance company will ask you or your doctor for additional information. You should respond promptly to their request so that they can process your claim.

In some cases, your doctor or hospital will submit the claim directly to the insurance company and wait to receive payment from them before billing you. Other medical providers will require you to pay in advance and seek reimbursement from your insurance company afterwards. You should ask about the payment arrangements before you receive treatment, so you know what to expect.

What to Do If You Get Sick

If you are ill or injured when UHS is open, you should go there for treatment. Otherwise, you should go to a local physician or urgent care clinic. For very serious illnesses or accidents, you can seek treatment in a hospital emergency room, but you should seek other options if your condition is not life-threatening. Similarly, if UHS does not offer treatment for dependents, you should select a family physician for them when you arrive in the U.S. If they need care when the doctor's office is closed, you can call his or her regular office telephone number and the answering service can contact the doctor right away.

How to File an Insurance Claim

After you receive medical treatment (except service at UHS), you need to notify the insurance company and request payment for them. This is called filing a claim. You should ask for a claim form when you first buy insurance and review it carefully to be sure you understand it. Part of the form is completed by you and part by the physician or facility that provided treatment.

Complete your section of the claim form and take it to the clinic or hospital where you were treated. Be sure you have filled your section out completely; then ask the health provider to complete the rest and submit the form to the company. The insurance company can then evaluate the treatment you received to determine if it is covered by your policy, and if so, to arrange payment. However, if your claim form is incomplete, payment may be delayed. You should provide all the requested information so that the insurance company can act on your claim properly.

What to Do If Your Claim Is Denied

Remember that most insurance policies have specific exclusions, that is, medical procedures not covered. You may submit a claim and later learn that the company has denied your request for payment. If you do not understand the reason for the denial, you should contact UHS or the insurance company. If you disagree with the decision of the insurance company, you have the right to appeal that decision and request the company to consider your case again. The insurance company can tell you about the specific procedure for filing an appeal.

Keeping Costs Manageable

Health care is the fastest-growing expense in the U.S. today. The increase in medical expenses are due to many factors including the cost of highly advanced and technical medical equipment and the litigious environment in the U.S. Choices you make when you need medical care can contribute to these high costs or help to control them. Seeking treatment at UHS whenever possible, using hospital emergency rooms only for life-threatening emergencies, filling out claim forms completely and accurately, and being a wise and well-informed medical consumer, you can help to limit costs. By working with your health care provider and insurance company, you can make responsible health care choices, help limit costs, and protect yourself from higher premiums in the future.

Public Aid Programs

There are programs in the United States when there is not enough money to pay expenses for medical care or food. International families may be tempted to apply to these programs offered in the United States, but those who are in the United States under an F or J visa cannot apply for these programs. Applying to them would be a violation to your immigration status.
