

Pre-Arrival Checklist

- Ensure you have submitted the appropriate documents for admission. Reach out to
 <u>Undergraduate Admissions</u> or the <u>Graduate College</u> for more information.
- undergraduate and graduate students should check their application portal to track their admission status. Once admitted, you will receive your Form I-20 electronically.
- Set up and access your <u>O-Key</u> <u>account</u> and OSU email. All official communication from OSU will be sent to this account.
- Pay **SEVIS I-901** fee online, once you receive your Form I-20.
- Contact your corresponding U.S. embassy or consulate and schedule your <u>visa interview</u>.

 - Check visa appointment wait times on the <u>Department of</u> <u>State</u> website.
- Prepare for your <u>visa appointment</u>
 - Gather all required documents
 - Complete the <u>DS-160</u> <u>Nonimmigrant Visa Application</u>
 - Check the website for the <u>U.S.</u>
 Consulate/Embassy
 - Prepare for the interview

- If you are required to take the Placement Exam, please visit the University Assessment and Testing webpage for more information.
- Complete online orientation through <u>Terra Dotta</u>. This online orientation is required for all new F-1 undergraduate and graduate international students.
- Undergraduate students must pay their enrollment deposit and register for Orientation and Enrollment through your application portal.
- After you submit your enrollment deposit, please register for housing.
- Review the <u>immunization</u>
 <u>requirements</u> and schedule
 your UHS health screening
 through the <u>Patient Portal</u> or
 by calling +1 (405) 744-7665.
- You can enter the U.S. up to 30 days before classes start. At the port of entry, present your passport, F-1 visa, Form I-20 and your admission letter.
- Become familiar with the requirements for maintaining your <u>F-1 status</u>.
